## POKER GENERAL ROOM RULES

## High Card ▶ 1 Pair ▶ 2 pairs ▶ 3 of a Kind ▶ Straight ▶ Flush Full House ▶ 4 of a Kind ▶ Straight Flush ▶ Royal Flush

- CARDS SPEAK: The winner of any called or checked hand must expose all their cards before the pot is awarded. Cards read for themselves. Dealers will assist in reading hands to the best of their ability, but it is the player's responsibility to protect their hand at all times.
- 2. ENGLISH ONLY WHILE THE CARDS ARE IN PLAY.
- 3. Electronic devices may be used while a player is seated at any of the Poker tables, such as, but not limited to, cell phones, PDAs, iPods, headphones, or Bluetooth earpieces. Talking/texting during a hand is prohibited. Please note that any violations of this rule will disqualify (kill) the player's hand, and money will not be refunded.
- Foreign objects, such as napkins, pocketbooks, etc., will not be allowed to be placed on any Poker table.
- Hoods, hats, or sunglasses may be worn at the Poker table; however, hoods or anything that covers the player's face must be removed upon leaving the table.
- 6. Players cannot communicate information about their hand to other players. This will result in both players' hands being disqualified (killed). Excessive violation of this rule will have the player(s) in question removed from the table and/or the Poker room.
- All players are responsible for making the best hand out of their cards and presenting their hand to the dealer face up for review.
- 8. An incorrect number of cards to any player may constitute a misdeal.
- 9. Tie hands split the pot.
- 10. An exposed card does not constitute a misdeal.
- 11. Players are not allowed to have side bets against each other.
- Each betting round shall consist of (1) bet and/or (3) raises maximum in limit games. In no-limit games, unlimited raises are permitted.
- Players may not change from one table to another without the consent of Poker personnel.
- 14. Players may not remove chips from the table except when quitting the game or paying for "incidentals," i.e., tips, food, cigarettes, etc.
- 15. Passing chips between players is not allowed on any Poker table.
- 16. A player has the right to an unimpeded view of an opponent's chips when requested.
- 17. If a player taps the table or indicates they pass, it is considered a check.
- If a player leaves the game for more than two absent buttons or 30 minutes, their chips will be picked up, and the player will be put on the bottom of the player waiting list.
- 19. ALLOWABLE WAGERS/BETS:
  - a. All wagers shall be made with gaming chips.
  - b. The player is responsible for protecting their hand, chips, and valuables.
  - c. Ashort bet or call in which chips have been released may be completed or forfeited.
- 20. STRING BETS are not allowed. If a bettor intends to raise, he should either put all the chips on the table at once or announce that he wants to raise.
- 21. Supervisors can stop players from drinking alcohol if they feel the customer has had too much to drink.
- 22. HOUSE RAKE: The house will collect 10% of the pot with a minimum of \$1 and a maximum of \$6.
  - a. When running it twice, an additional \$1 will be collected.

## SEVEN CARD GAMES JACKPOT RULES

(Texas Hold'em & Seven Card Stud)

- 1. A Royal Flush is defined as the Ten, Jack, Queen, King, and Ace of the same suit.
- Texas Hold'em players must use both cards in their hand to win. Players must use the best five-card combination to win.
- 3. Seven card players must use two hole cards and three face up cards to win.
- The treasury will collect and count all jackpot drop boxes daily, with the funds added to the promotional cash fund.
- All promotional payouts will be paid in chips or cash as documented on the payout form.
- 6. The Royal Flush jackpot amount and daily increase are as follows:

Suit	Base Amount	Daily Increas
Royal in Spades (AK)*	\$500	\$500
Royal in Diamonds**	\$250	\$250
Royal in Hearts**	\$250	\$250
Royal in Clubs**	\$250	\$250

\*Royal Flush of Spades will be "capped" at \$100,000.

"Royal Flush of Diamonds, Hearts, and Clubs will be "capped" at \$5,000.

- a. In order to obtain Royal Flush in Spades, a player must contain the "A" and "K" spades in their hand to qualify.
  - i. Any other two cards will obtain a set amount of \$500.
- b. Once a progressive has been "capped", it will continue to accumulate daily and the funds will go towards the Poker promotional fund.
- Royal Flush prizes will be updated on a daily basis with the indicated amounts above.
- Once the progressive Royal Flush jackpot is obtained, it will start back at the base amount.
  - If any Spades Royal is obtained, whether it be (AK) or any two cards, the amount will not increase for the following day.
- P. High-Hand Promotion (Texas Hold'em & Seven Card) qualifies. Texas Hold'em players must use one hole card and play the best five. Stud players must use two hole cards and three up cards, no ties. Once a hand is established, it will take a higher hand to win.
- Single and multi-table tournaments will qualify for all eligible promotions except for all Royal Flush jackpots, unless otherwise noted.
  - For single table tournament, a designated portion of the per buy-in money will be dropped for the benefit of the jackpot. The amounts are as follows: \$5/\$10 for Texas Hold'em.
- 11. The house must verify all jackpot hands before the jackpot can be paid. This includes the number of burn cars, proper dealing techniques, deck verification, count, etc.
- 12. Any jackpot and/or prize won or obtained by illegal means, cheating, or use of cheating devices, collusion, theft, fraud, or scam to defraud the enterprise will not be honored. The violator(s) will be subject to criminal prosecution.
- 3. Patrons must present their M Sphere Rewards card to receive the prize.
- 14. Players intentionally attempting to alter the outcome of this promotion may be disqualified or asked to leave.
- 15. Players must be at least 18 years of age to participate.
- Players must have valid, government-issued, gaming-approved ID to claim the prize. The prize will be retained for 30 days if valid, government-issued, gamingapproved ID is not provided at the time of win.
- 17. For all seven card games, a \$3 jackpot rake will be taken per hand. a. An additional \$2 will be collected when running it twice.
- House Rake: The house will collect 10% of the pot: a minimum of \$1 and a maximum of \$6 per hand.
  - a. When running it twice, an additional \$1 will be collected.
- 19. Miccosukee Reserves the right to modify or cancel a promotion at any time.

## EIGHT OR NINE CARD GAMES JACKPOT RULES

- A Royal Flush is defined as the Ten, Jack, Queen, King, and Ace of the same suit.
  A jackpot prize will go to the person who holds two cards in their hand, of the same suit along with the "three" cards on the "flop" that would constitute that particular Royal Flush of that particular suit.
- The treasury will collect and count all jackpot drop boxes daily, adding the funds to the promotional cash fund.
- All promotional payouts will be paid in chips or cash as documented on the payout form.
- 5. The Royal Flush jackpot amount and daily increase are as follows:

<u>Suit</u>	<u>Base Amount</u>	Daily Increase
Royal in Any Suit (AK)*	\$500	\$500

\*Royal Flush jackpot amount will be "capped" at \$50,000.

- a. Once a progressive has been "capped", it will continue to accumulate daily and the funds will go towards the Poker promotional fund.
- b. In order to obtain the progressive Royal Flush jackpot, a player must contain the "A" and "K" of any suit in their hand to qualify.
- 6. Royal Flush prizes will be updated on a daily basis with the indicated amounts above.
- A Royal Flush attained by any other two cards will not qualify for any prize payout amount.
- Once the progressive Royal Flush jackpot is obtained, it will start back at the base amount.
  - High Hand promotional payouts for 8-9 card games are outlined below: a. If obtained on the flop, they will receive 100% of the amount. b. In all other occurrences (turn or river), the amount will be subject to 50%.
- 10. High Hand promotions do qualify in the instances that the board is run "multiple times" but do not qualify for the Royal Flush progressive.
  - For single table tournament, a designated portion of the per buy-in money will be dropped for the benefit of the jackpot. The amounts are as follows: \$5/\$10.
- 11. Single and multi-table tournaments will qualify for eligible promotions except for all royal flush jackpots except when otherwise noted.
  - For single table tournament, a designated portion of the per buy-in money will be dropped for the benefit of the jackpot. The amounts are as follows: \$5/\$10.
- All jackpots obtained must be verified by the house before the jackpot can be paid. This includes number of burn cards, proper dealing techniques, deck verification, and count etc.
- 13. Any jackpot and/or prize won or obtained by illegal means, cheating, or use of cheating devices, collusion theft, fraud, or scam to defraud the enterprise will not be honored. The violator(s) will be subject to criminal prosecution.
- 14. Patrons must present their M Sphere Rewards card to receive the prize.
- 15. Players intentionally attempting to alter the outcome of this promotion may be disqualified or asked to leave.
- 16. Players must be at least 18 years of age to participate.
- Players must have valid, government-issued, gaming-approved ID to claim the prize. The prize will be retained for 30 days if valid, government-issued, gamingapproved ID is not provided at the time of win.
- 18. For each Omaha, Tahoe, or pineapple game, a \$3 jackpot rake will be taken per hand.
  - a. When running it twice, an additional \$2 will be collected.
- 19. House Rake: The house will collect 10% of the pot: a minimum of \$1 and a maximum of \$6 per hand.
  - a. When running it twice, an additional \$1 will be collected.
- 20. Miccosukee reserves the right to modify or cancel the promotion at any time.
